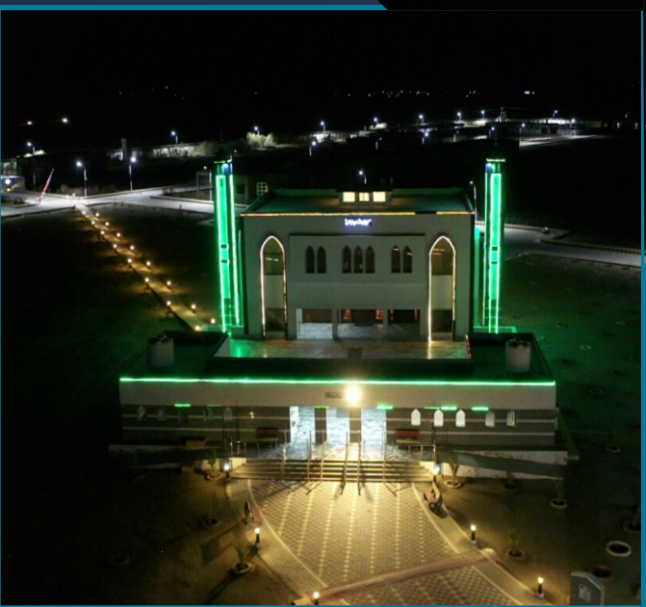

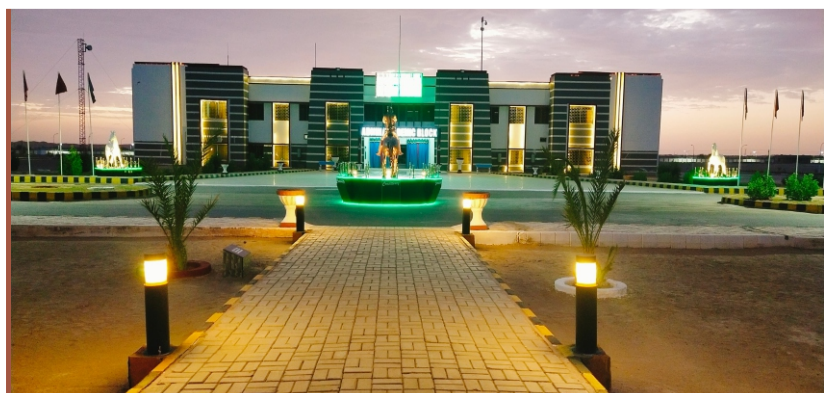

## 02 INTRODUCTION

Cadet Colleges have been established with an aim to uplift and steer the standard of education in the province and to survive in the hyper competitive era. Cadet College Noshki being a part of that pivotal policy was established with a focus on principal of learning and transfer of training to the young cadets.

The college is located on Quetta - Taftan national highway 7 km away from Noshki city at district Noshki of Balochistan, Pakistan. It lies southwest of Quetta, and is situated in a plain at the base of the Quetta plateau, 2,900 feet above sea level. From Noshki the flat Balochistan golden desert stretches away northward and westwards to the Helmand River.

## 08 OBJECTIVES

### Our decisive objectives are:

- To provide professional development and constant supervision to the cadets and to help them find meaning in their lives and curriculum.
- To uplift the infrastructure of college including laboratories, auditorium, play grounds, hostels, library etc.
- To raise the standard of the institution and to bring it at par with the other established educational institutions of the country.



## 09 ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCE

The college is an autonomous organization administrated by a Board of Governors chaired by honorable Governor of Balochistan and executive committee headed by the Secretary Higher and Technical Education, Government of Balochistan. The principal is serving Army officer who is the head of the institution. He is responsible for the day to day administrative and academic affairs of the college in accordance with the rules devised and approved by the Board of Governors. The college is financed by the Government of Balochistan in shape of Grand-in-Aid to function smoothly.



## 10 DISCIPLINE

Maintaining a high standard of discipline is the hallmark of the college. It plays a very significant role in grooming and moulding the cadets into a wholesome personality as the highly useful future citizens of the country.

### Daily Routine

While in the college, cadets have to follow the daily routine. The purpose of daily routine is to make a balanced time distribution for each activity. This is mandatory not only for their academics but also for physical growth.

### Annual Calendar

An annual calendar is issued with prior approval of the principal. It includes schedule of all the events competitions, examinations, term breaks and vacations.

### Prayers

All the prayers are compulsory for all cadets, except non-muslims.

### Absence from College

The name of the cadet will be struck off from the college role after six days of an unauthorized absence, without any notice.

### Parents Visiting Days

Parents and guest are allowed to see the cadets only on specified Sunday (Parents visiting days) according to the annual calendar.

### Extra Money

Parents should not give any extra money to the cadets, if any cash more than Rs. 500/- is found with the cadet, the amount will be confiscated and will not be refunded. However, parents may deposit extra money with the concerned House Master, who shall keep record of such money. Cadets may get the money from the House Master once a week or as per requirement.



## 11 RE-ADMISSION

There will be re-admission in 1st year class as per admission rules.

### Dress Inspection

Dress inspection is carried out on every Monday to ensure proper turnout of the cadets.

### Rules and Regulations

- The cadet is admitted to the college only on the conditions that he will abide by the rules and regulations of the college and any violation of rules and regulations will make him liable to expulsion.
- The college can not be held responsible for any illness, injury, accident, disability or death of a cadet once cadet is out of the premises of the college.
- A cadet can be expelled from the college on the following grounds. Stealing, cheating, willful and deliberate damage to the college property, using unfair means in the examinations, repeated absence without leave, failing in examination, Consistent ill discipline, possession of firearms of any kind, subversive activity, smoking, use of narcotics, toxicant and unauthorized medicine, abandonment from college, insolent behavior with the staff, fighting, harassing juniors, immoral offence of any kind whatsoever, grave misconduct outside the college campus or any action likely to violate the good order of the principal requires expulsion from the college. In case of serious offence, a cadet may be expelled without previous warning.

## 12 DRESSES

Cadets have to be in the prescribed dress while they are in the college.

## 13 ACCIDENTS / MISHAPS

All possible measures, for the safety of the cadets during their stay in college campus, are taken. However, the college shall not be held responsible for any kind of accident / mishap causing any physical injury or death.

## 14 LEAVE

Leave other than the breaks, scheduled and announced by the college, will not be granted except in exceptional circumstances of genuine nature. No leave will be granted to attend wedding ceremonies except that of real brothers and sisters.



## 15 HOUSE SYSTEM

Cadet College Noshki is a fully residential institution. All cadets live in the college. Cadets of an entry are divided and accommodated equally in each of two Houses. Each House is under the supervision of a House Master (HM) appointed from the teaching faculty.

There are certain appointments from senior cadets of each House, called a House Prefect and Assistant House Prefect. They organize House activities and prepare their House for the Inter House Competitions.

Each House has an anteroom where cadets relax and enjoy homely atmosphere, take pleasure in reading magazines and newspapers. Arrangements are available for indoor games and recreations. The cadets are trained in the virtues of team spirit, self-confidence and a high sense of responsibility. They grow up as useful citizens to enjoy a purposeful life. They learn to respect the authority of seniors and in turn when they are entrusted with responsibility, they know how to discharge it with reverence.



## 16 MEDICAL FACILITY

The college has its own hospital. If any cadet feels sick, he will have proper treatment by a qualified doctor and competent staff. In addition to the general treatment, the cadets are given preliminary vaccines against typhoid, cholera, tetanus and hepatitis-B. If necessary, the cadet may be referred to concerned specialists for further treatment. The expenses for such consultation / treatment are to be borne by parents.





## 17 CADETS' MESS

It consists of a big hall with the capacity of about 400 cadets to dine at a time. The mess works under the supervision of Mess Committee headed by a senior faculty member (President Mess Committee) who is further assisted by a messing officer and a storekeeper with other staff like; chief cook, head cook, cooks, bearers, masalchies and helpers. Best possible menu is served in the mess to provide a healthy food to the students.



## 18 LABS & LIBRARY

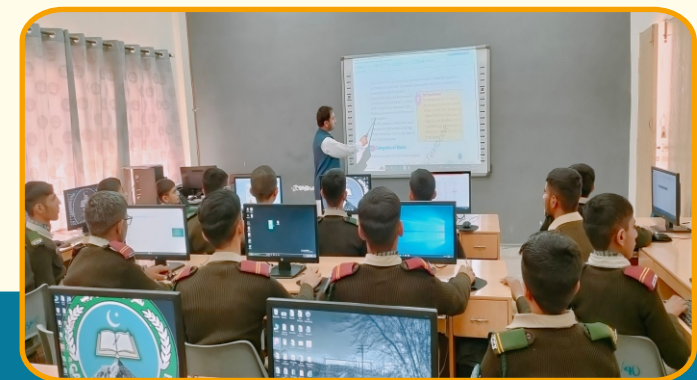
Laboratories and library play a vital role in the study. In the absence of fully equipped and operational laboratories, completion of courses is beyond comprehension. Cadet College Noshki is facilitated with modern science laboratories for Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

The college library is also functioning at full swing with a huge number and a variety of books. The cadets are getting full benefit and utilizing. The library to broaden then studies. The library has syllabus as well as general reading books.



## 19 COURSE OFFERED

The college is affiliated with Balochistan Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education (BBISE) Quetta. Cadets are offered only science subjects both at the secondary and higher secondary levels (Pre-Medical and Pre-Engineering). No art and computer stream is offered. Admissions are granted in 7th class only.





## 20 EXAMINATION

The curriculum is based on the syllabus prescribed by the Balochistan Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education Quetta. Cadet College Noshki conducts following examinations in order to evaluate progress of the cadets.

## 21 FORTNIGHT TESTS

These are held on a regular basis after the completion of a portion of study. This helps to evaluate the academic progress of the cadets and inculcate habit of regular studies.

## 22 MONTHLY TESTS

At the end of each month, the cadets are to undergo a monthly test. This is helpful to observe their progress after a specified period. The parents are also informed about the progress of their sons / wards by the college on monthly basis.

## 23 PROMOTION (ANNUAL) EXAMINATION

Promotion / annual examination are held after the completion of each session (Term). The students will be promoted to the next class after qualifying the annual exams conducted by college. A cadet has to qualify promotion (Annual) examination by obtaining 40% marks in each subject otherwise he will not be promoted to the next class.





## 24 CO / EXTRA - CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Cadet College Noshki emphasizes on both academic and physical training of the cadets. Co-curriculum / extra curricular activities are very essential for the moral grooming, discipline and confidence of the cadets. These are especially addressed by utilizing all the available resources. All the events are scheduled in annual calendar and observed actively with full interest by the cadets.

## 25 SPORTS

Sports activities are essential for physical fitness. To achieve this goal the college is providing the best available facilities for all major games e.g. cricket, football, volleyball, handball, basketball etc. There are inter house competitions and all the cadets have full opportunity to participate in their favorite sports.

## 26 OTHER ACTIVITIES

To develop a healthy sense of competition among the cadets, debates in English, Urdu, General knowledge, Geography, Science Quiz, Spelling, Naat, Hamd and Qirat contests are held regularly at house as well as at college level. In fact, Inter-house competitions, in all fields are the deciding factors for the overall house position towards the general college championship.

## 27 RECREATIONS

Besides sports, games, hobbies and co-curricular activities, the cadets are provided with the facility of TV in mess hall and indoor games gear in the college for leisure time occupation. There is also a recreation movie club, which arranges screening of English movies on week-ends. Excursion trips, hiking, variety programs, dramas and many other activities are also organized.





## 28 REGULAR FEE STRUCTURE

## 29 SELF - FINANCE SCHEME

1. Annual dues are Rs. 260,000/- to be payable into equal installments.

**Rs. 147,000/=** can be deposited into the college online account or a bank draft in favor of Principal Cadet College Noshki which may be submitted by hand at the time of reporting.

### • **LATE PAYMENT**

- If dues are not received, till March 31st and August 1st each year, a fine will be charged as under:  
Rs. 50/- per day for the first 7 days.  
Rs. 100/- per day for the subsequent period.
- If the dues are not paid even after 45 days, the admission is likely to be cancelled.
- Dues and fees once paid are not refundable and college shall not be accountable to the parents in regard with the utilization of the deposited money.



## 30 SCHOLARSHIP

The Government of Balochistan offers scholarships to support those deserving cadets who belong to Balochistan province and their parents are government employees with insufficient income to afford their education. The terms and conditions to avail scholarships are as under:

- These scholarships are based on academic performance and discipline of the cadets. Scholarships are awarded in accordance with the decision taken by the prescribed committee.
- If a cadet fails in annual / promotion examination or if his behavior is not satisfactory, the scholarship is to be withdrawn.
- These scholarships are subject to the availability of the government funds.
- Scholarships are awarded initially for 6- months.





## 31 HOW TO JOIN CADET COLLEGE NOSHKI

If you want to join us, you have to qualify an entry test conducted by the college. Your satisfactory performance in interview, your medical fitness and finally grabbing the top order in the merit list can enable you to be a part of this prestigious college. This requires your hard work and concentration towards the goal. If you prove yourself, Cadet College Noshki will warmly welcome you among the squad of "Noshkal"

### **Admission:**

Admissions are opened once in a year in class VII; subject to fulfillment of the general conditions.

### **Announcement:**

Admissions are announced through the leading English and Urdu newspapers in the month of November each year.

### **Eligibility:**

Male citizens of Pakistan are eligible to apply against the seats allocation to their respective district / province.

The allocation of seats is as below;

• District Seats	61
• Other Province	03
• Self-Finance	06
• Minorities	01
<b>Total</b>	<b>71</b>

**Note:** In case a seat remains vacant in any district that seat shall be given to that respective division, however if a seat remains vacant in a division, that seat shall be shifted to the province, keeping in view the descending order.



## Age

Candidates must be over 11 and under 13 years of age on 31st of March in the year of admission. No relaxation of age whatsoever is permissible.

## Qualification

Candidates must have passed class VI (Six Grade) examination at the time of admission.

## Entrance Examination

Selection of candidates is made through written test, interview and medical examination. Written test will be conducted by the college and will be of the class-VI standard. The following subjects are included in written test:

- English
- Mathematics
- Urdu
- General Science

**Note:** The syllabus for the above mentioned papers will be the same as of Balochistan Text Book Board for Class 6th.

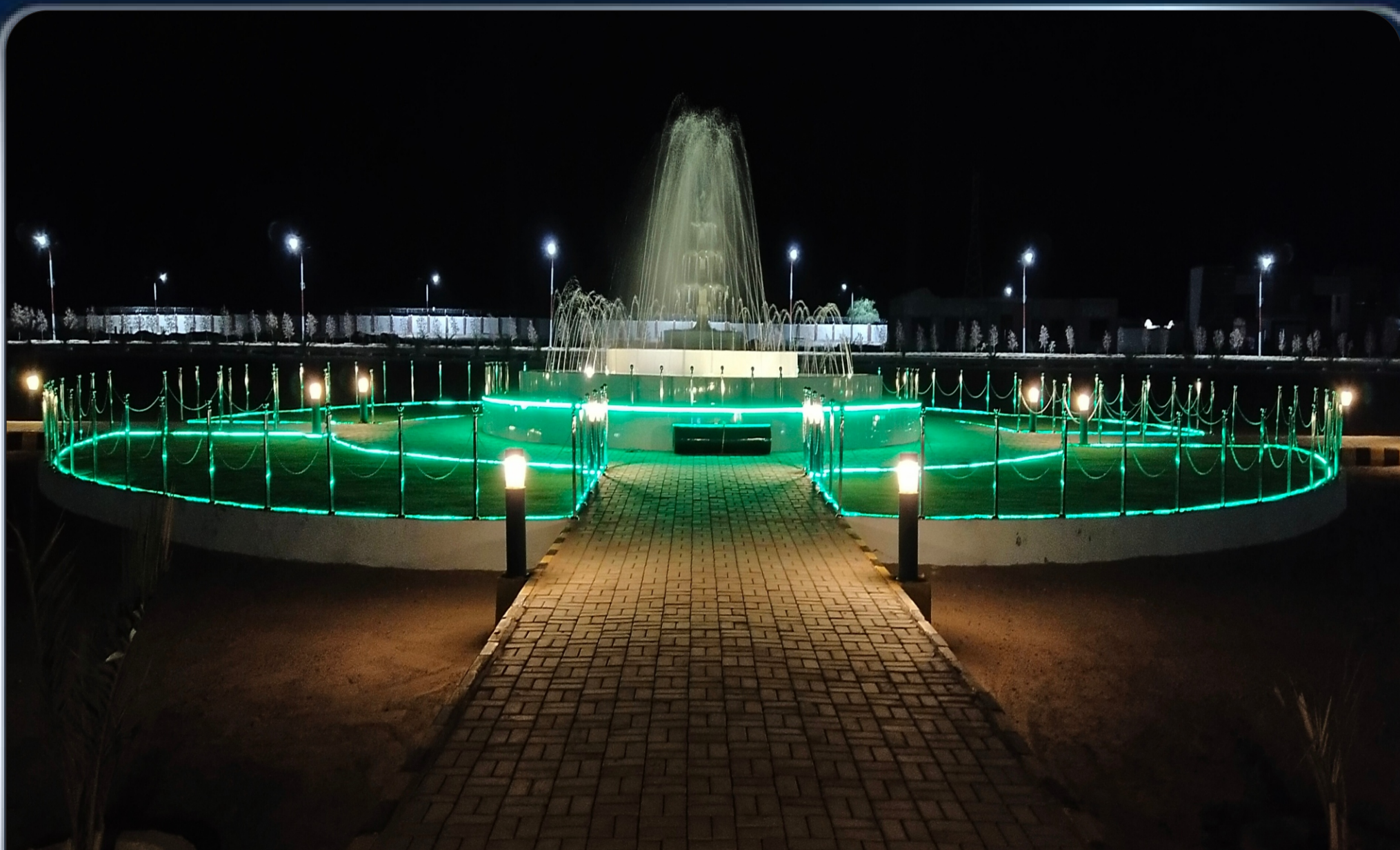
## Selection Procedures
